COVID-19:

- RUGBY OHIO PLANS TO PLAY RUGBY UNION RULES WITH NO MODIFICATIONS FOR THE 2021 SPRING SEASON. OHSAA FOOTBALL, SOCCER, WRESTLING AND BASKETBALL HAVE ALL PROCEEDED THIS SCHOOL YEAR WITHOUT MAJOR INCIDENT.

- PRE-GAME COVID-19 PROTOCOLS WILL BE USED UNLESS DEEMED UNNECESSARY BY HEALTH OFFICIALS - YOU WILL RECEIVE THOSE FROM US PRIOR TO MARCH.

- UNLESS A LARGE NUMBER OF TEAMS ARE SOMEHOW PROHIBITED FROM PLAYING, TRAVELING, HOSTING OR OTHERWISE PARTICIPATING IN THE SEASON, WE PLAN FOR THE SEASON TO START AS SCHEDULED.


- WE WILL BE FLEXIBLE WITH, AND SUPPORTIVE OF, THOSE TEAMS WHO HAVE PROHIBITIONS FROM THEIR SCHOOLS, PARK MANAGERS, ETC. - BUT IF YOU CANNOT HONOR THE SCHEDULE GIVEN - YOU WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED TO BE A COMPETITIVE CLUB FOR THE 2021 SEASON. RUGBY OHIO WILL CONTINUE TO SUPPORT YOUR PROGRAM AND THE MATCHES YOU ARE ABLE TO HONOR IN ORDER TO KEEP YOUR KIDS PLAYING RUGBY.

- THE BIGGEST IMPACT WE ANTICIPATE FROM COVID-19 TO OUR PLANNED COMPEITION STRUCTURE IS THE POTENTIAL TO CHANGE THE GIRLS FROM 4 DIVISIONS TO 2 DIVISIONS.
