

Game Prep & Setup

Every team has played at least one game! Thank you to everyone for continuing to put in the hard work on behalf of these players. We've had a number of items come up that suggest a need for some important game preparation reminders.

- <u>Confirm game details with assigned referee and trainer</u>. Ref and trainer assignments, along
 with contact info, can be found on the <u>Spring 2022 LIVE master game schedule</u>. This file is saved
 to the <u>Coaches Info</u> page of the Rugby Ohio website, under Reference Documents, and is
 updated multiple times a day. Please check back often.
- <u>Team Sheets.</u> Most teams are doing a great job with getting team sheets completed before kickoff. Make sure the jersey number on the team sheet is the number worn by the player in the game. If your team sheet is inaccurate it may lead to players being sanctioned by the Ohio Rugby Disciplinary Board for actions they didn't commit.
- <u>Technical Zones.</u> Technical zones are required to be in place by USA Rugby. Please refer to this
 document for various field setup requirements, depending on the type of venue you use. This
 document is also stored in the Reference Documents section of the Coaches Info page. If the
 referee indicates that TZs were not set up and/or used, the home team will be issued a warning.
 Subsequent offenses will be recorded as forfeits by the home team.
- <u>Ice for trainer.</u> The home team is required to provide ice in a cooler on the field for use by the
 athletic trainer.
- <u>Updated coach contact list.</u> Remember, only coaches without yellow highlighted cells, but who are on this list are eligible to be on the sidelines.
