Level 1 Coach (and other) Courses

Thanks to all of you who attended the Training & Education weekend in Pataskala in November. There are 2 additional weekends for coach courses in the next month within our region. It is highly unlikely that USA Rugby will be able to support any other course requests before the spring season begins.

Sunday, January 21st, Pittsburgh PA: Level 1 Coach & Level 1 Referee

Saturday & Sunday, February 10th & 11th, Avon IN: Level 1 & Level 2 Coach, Level 1 & Level 2 Referee, Coach of Match Officials, Strength & Conditioning

To register for a class, please login to your RX profile. You'll see an option for the Learning Center. Go to the Course Catalog, select the course you are looking for and register. Online course requirements are also completed and managed through the Learning Center. Once all requirements have been met, you'll see your completed certification under 'Accreditations' in your RX profile.

Please take the opportunity to attend one of these two courses if you still need to become certified as a coach or referee. Only certified, registered coaches are eligible to work with players and be on the sidelines during games.

Spring Schedules Due by 12/31

Spring schedules were due in to Rugby Ohio last month. To date we have received about 25% of them. Please submit them ASAP. We've updated the live documents that we share with you. The coach contact list from the end of last spring can be found there. Your assigned home and away matches for the spring season are there, as is a master calendar view of all scheduled games. This will be updated as we receive home game schedules from coaches. Keep in mind that you can schedule games in addition to your assigned league games.

League games are to be scheduled between March 4th and May 5th. Others may be scheduled outside of this window, on either end.

Quarterfinals: Saturday & Sunday, May 18 & 19 Semifinals: Saturday & Sunday, May 25 & 26 State Championships: Saturday, June 1

Please submit your home games as soon as you can and no later than December 15th.

Coach & Admin Compliance

All adults involved with youth and high school rugby are required to be registered. USA Rugby, World Rugby and SafeSport are all clamping down on compliance. At the club level, you are the ones who know who should be registered. You also have visibility on the accreditations of those registered through the Admin Portal of Rugby Xplorer.

Each registered adult is able to see his/her accreditations in their own profile. From the Rugby Xplorer app, in the Profile section, scroll down to accreditations. They should look something like this:

Spring Registration

Spring Registration is now setup and open in Rugby Xplorer.

- Season fee is \$120; Late registration (after 3/15) is \$130
- Clubs who want to add team dues to registration need to do that now.
 - Login to the Admin Portal of Rugby Xplorer
 - Click on Payment Settings and the subheading Payment Settings
 - Click on the spring registration type(s) shown for your club.
 - Add your club fee and click the arrow to the right
 - Click save at the bottom
- Teams with competitive schedules are required to have a minimum of 15 players registered by February 1st.
- Additional sides are added as follows:
 - 35-59 players = 2 sides
 - 60-84 players = 3 sides
